Conditions and General Provisions:

1. The customer is waving their three day right to cancel. The work is to be performed in a timely manner that is customary in the industry.
2. The customer is assigning the value of benefits for the tree removal portion **ONLY**, to Casey's Tree Service LLC.
3. The customer hereby authorizes Casey's Tree Service LLC the right to bill their insurance carrier directly for services provided.
4. The customer grants Casey's Tree Service the right to receive direct payment from the insurance carrier for services provided. Customer specifically requests that the

payment for the tree portion of the claim be mailed directly to Casey's Tree Service LLC at 1107 US 60, Mountain View, Missouri 65548.

5. The customer acknowledges that all work performed will be in compliance with OSHA and ANSI standards. The determination of what is the safest and best plan of action will be determined by Casey's Tree Service LLC. All actions will be based on local and federal laws.
6. In the event that there is a discrepancy in the value of service, the customer will assist Casey's Tree Service LLC in seeking appraisal for the value of services rendered.
7. Below is our rate schedule for emergency work. We define emergency work as work that is not scheduled at least three weeks in advance. The customer is expressly stating that they deem the scope of work as an emergency and are asking that the work be performed immediately. All rates are an eight hour minimum, which is standard in the industry. Normal hours are 8am to 5pm. Any work, including port to port outside of those hours are charged at 1.5 times the standard hourly rate. All rates will be the actual hours on site, plus one hour travel each way, commonly called port to port travel, but not less than eight hours. This time allows for equipment set up, tear down, trip inspections, and travel time. Below is a list of our most common equipment and fees, but is not limited to this list. A check mark next to the fees below indicates we are expecting to use this line item, but isn't limited to those items. Labor persons will vary depending on equipment used:

1. _____ Grapple Saw Crane + Operator \$8,000.00
Grapple saw crane used for cutting and lifting sections of tree material. Also allows removal of tree debris from crane landing zone. Price includes operator.
2. _____ Grapple Truck w/ Boom + Operator \$4,500.00
Crane used for lifting sections of tree material. Also allows removal of tree debris from crane landing zone. Price includes operator.
3. _____ 1-40 Ton Crane + Operator \$5,600.00
Medium capacity crane used for lifting sections of tree material. Price includes operator.
4. _____ 41-64 Ton Crane + Operator \$6,000.00
High capacity crane used for lifting large sections of tree material. Price includes operator.
5. _____ 65-100 Ton Crane + Operator \$7,200.00
High capacity crane used for lifting large sections of tree material. Price includes operator.
6. _____ 101-135 Ton Crane + Operator \$8,000.00
High capacity crane used for lifting large sections of tree material. Price includes operator.
7. _____ Aerial Lift/Bucket Truck \$2,850.00
Lift is used to hoist personnel whenever possible. It is much safer than traditional climbing methods.

8. _____ Skid Steer \$1,650.00
Used to move material to allow safe work areas for the crew. Also allows removal of material from the crane landing zone.
 9. _____ L28 Loader \$1,650.00
Used to move material to allow safe work areas for the crew. Also allows removal of material from the crane landing zone.
 10. _____ Stump Grinder \$2,500.00
Machine is key in removing roots that are still attached to root balls. Roots must be cut to allow the grapple crane to lift the stump.
 11. _____ Labor, Per Person # _____ \$ 600.00
Includes spotters, riggers, sawyers, lift operators, skid steer operators, L28 operators, stump grinder operators.
 12. _____ Ground Protection Plywood, Per Sheet # _____ \$ 20.00
Plywood sheets are used allow ingress and egress of heavy equipment and to mitigate further loss of property.
 13. _____ Auxiliary Job Site Lighting, Per Light # _____ \$ 85.00
Allows for safe work area during low difficult lighting for the crew.
 14. _____ Debris Hauling %10 of all equipment and labor
Covers material removed from curb to an approved disposal location.
 15. _____ Administrative Fee, Per Invoice \$ 350.00
Covers administrative, technological, and communication costs for mitigation work.
8. The property and tree are to be delivered in a stable and safe working environment. Casey's Tree Service LLC **WILL Not** be responsible for any unmarked or marked subterranean utilities or structures. Furthermore, Casey's Tree Service LLC will use reasonable care to protect driveways and sidewalks by using appropriate ground protection for ingress and egress. Any failure while using plywood sheets are not the responsibility of Casey's Tree Service LLC, but a condition of the environment related to the work.
 9. Customer expressly agrees to assist Casey's Tree Service LLC get paid by the carrier. Any legal fees arising from nonpayment or checks held will be the responsibility of the homeowner. Any proceedings involving collection will be held in the Howell County Missouri court system.
 10. Any balance not collected after 30 days will be assessed a 5% late fee, per month.
